Releases small amounts of hormone into the body over several years. This prevents pregnancy by:

> 1) thickening of cervical mucus to block sperm

2) Stopping of ovulation (releasing of an egg from the ovary). No egg = no pregnancy.

Sperm doesn't like copper! The Copper IUD stops sperm from being able to "swim" to the egg. If sperm can't reach the egg, pregnancy can't happen!


